Camp Berry- is located south of Findlay off State Route 68.

In 1928 Mr. and Mrs. RJ Berry purchased 83 acres and donated it to the local Boy Scout Council in memory of their daughter. The Berry Boy Scout Reservation was incorporated that year. In the mid 1960s land was donated and purchased increasing the camp to its current size of 360 acres. At the same time, Eagle Creek was rerouted and the a four acre Lake of the Pines was created. In the 1990s, Donnell Lodge and other cabins were refurbished, Howard Lodge was built and a second lake was formed. Today the camp has campsites for resident tent camping, cabins for winter camping, a modern pool and bath house, two lakes, a nature pond and assorted support buildings. All camp facilities may be rented by Cub Scout, Boy Scout or Venturing Units and by the general public.

Camp Lakota— Is located just outside of Defiance, Ohio.

Lakota was first established in 1941 for the purpose of “helping boys retain their Scouting ideals for the guidance of their adult lives.” Now featuring 640 acres of land, including two sub camps- Lakota and Neil Armstrong-Camp Lakota features 17 campsites and a lake of almost 50 acres. Camp Lakota is considered by many to provide a “rustic” summer camp experience. We know you will enjoy all that Camp Lakota has to offer, and we welcome you to the Lakota Experience!
