
THE CUB SCOUT HANDSHAKE

Hold this in front of a mirror to find out what the motto is. It means:



Can you figure out what this says:_




LOYAL means that you will keep your Cub Scout Promise.

Make the sign with your arm held straight up, with the first two fingers forming a "V".


The two fingers stand for two parts of the Cub Scout Promise - "to help other people" and "obey". They look like a wolf's ears ready to listen to Akela.

Color the box below that shows the correct sign:












I promise to do my best. To do my duty to God and my country, To help other people, and To obey the Law of the Pack.
