## **Sled Race Scoring Guidelines**

## Material to be provided by Station Master:

Bags of rock salt or sand tubes (enough to load up to 4 sleds with 300 lbs)

Cones or other objects for creating course

4 Stopwatches for timing

The race course distance will be somewhere between ¼ and ½ mile long and established by district staff. The patrol will start with an empty sled to which they must add the provided weight (200 - 300 lbs depending upon age group). There will be two age divisions: 13 and under and 14 and older. Scoring will be based on time.

20 points will be awarded for participation

Additional points are awarded at the end of the day for speed in completing the course:

Fastest time	30 pts
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	27 pts
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	24 pts
4 <sup>th</sup> place	21 pts
5 <sup>th</sup> place	18 pts
6 <sup>th</sup> place	15 pts
7 <sup>th</sup> place	12 pts
8 <sup>th</sup> place	9 pts
9 <sup>th</sup> place	6 pts
10 <sup>th</sup> place	3 pts
11 <sup>th</sup> place and lower	0 pts
