

## **Snow Volleyball Scoring Guidelines (Run by the SPL's)**

### **Material to be provided by Station Master:**

2 Snow Volleyball Courts

2 Volleyballs

Two walls out of snow will separate each patrol so that they cannot see the ball until it comes back over the wall at them. Other than that it is just a normal game of volleyball. This will be run as a tournament. Each patrol will be given a time to show up at this event. Patrols more than ten minutes late will forfeit their match. Winners of each match will be paired up against each other after the afternoon sessions to determine the overall camporee winner.

### **Snow Volleyball Rules**

1. Patrols must have equal number of participants on the court at all times (maximum of eight per side). Additional patrol members will line up at the edge of the court.
2. Additional patrol members will rotate in every time a serve is won. If there are no extra players, patrol members must rotate positions every time a serve is won.
3. Patrols must have a minimum of 6 players to start/play. Patrols with less than required number of players will be asked to combine with another patrol or forfeit that game.
4. Patrols will rally for serve.
5. A point is scored on every rally.
6. Games are 20 minutes in length; sides are switched after 10 minutes.
7. Score will be cumulative (doesn't stop at 15)
8. If final score of the game is tied at time limit, Patrols will rally for serve. Play will continue in a sudden death format with the first patrol scoring a point winning the game.
9. Rotation of players will take place after a player has had 5 consecutive serves.
10. Net serve is loss of serve.
11. Disallowed skills include jump serves, spiking, kicking of the ball and blocking of serves.
12. Referees have been instructed to call basic rules and their decisions are final.
13. The winners of each game will be forwarded to the playoffs to be held in the afternoon.

30 points will be awarded for participation

Additional points are awarded at the end of the day for the following places in the finals:

1 <sup>st</sup> place	20 pts
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	15 pts
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	10 pts
4 <sup>th</sup> place	5 pts
5 <sup>th</sup> place and lower	0 pts

Total points possible: 50 points
