

## **Ski-Walk Slalom Scoring Guidelines**

### **Material to be provided by Station Master:**

Four pairs of land skis (2" x 6" x 8') with a 4-5 foot rope attached at the front and rear.

Cones or objects to create a simple course with 2 slight turns.

Course should be around 50 feet long.

Each patrol is provided with a pair of very large wooden skis which are just large enough to accommodate all team members. Only the front and rear skiers will have ropes attached to the skis. They have to work together to ensure that they can maneuver their team along a slalom course. It sounds easy, but requires great co-ordination and communication to move first the left ski, then the right ski and so on as they navigate the course. If they fall over or leave the skis in any way, they must return to the start.

15 points will be awarded for participation

20 additional points will be awarded for successfully completing the course.

Additional points are earned for speed in completing the course:

Under 10 minutes	15 pts
10-15 minutes	10 pts
15-20 minutes	5 pts
Over 20 minutes	0 pts

Total points possible: 50 points
