Event #7 Sled Balance Scoring Guidelines

Material to be provided by Station Master:

Wood platform on balance beam Stopwatches for timing

Sled Balance

Assemble 4' x 8' wooden platform and lay it over a 6" X 6" X 8' pressure treated post. The Patrol has to get on the platform one member at a time along with their sled and balance the platform so that neither side touches the ground. If the platform touches the ground 3 times before all patrol members and their sled are on, all patrol members and the sled will have to get off and start over. Points will be given for establishing balance with the entire patrol and the sled on the platform.

10 points will be awarded for participation

20 points will be awarded for successfully balancing the patrol and sled Up to 20 additional points are awarded at the end of the day for balancing the patrol and sled with the fewest ground touches:

Fewest Touches	20 pts
2 nd place	18 pts
3 rd place	16 pts
4 th place	14 pts
5 th place	12 pts
6 th place	10 pts
7 th place	8 pts
8 th place	6 pts
9 th place	4 pts
10 th place	2 pts
11 th place and lower	0 pts

Total time to complete the task will only be used to break ties.
