**Set-up & Clean-up** = Parents and boy come 15 minutes early to help set up tables and chairs. After meeting clean up, put chairs back, make sure no cookies/cups/drinks are spilled or laying around, and take garbage to the dumpster.

**Opening & Closing** = Opening: Present colors and begin Pledge and Scout Promise. Closing: Dismiss colors.

**Program** = Den leaders choice, practice at den meeting, to last at least 10 minutes....here you can choose to do a magic show, music performance, sing songs, show and do craft, or any other item listed in your Requirements for your badges.

**Snack & Kitchen Duty** = Bring cookies, etc., so each boy and sibling may have two each (about 6 dozen). Parents ONLY of that den will make drink (provided), pour drink into cups, arrange cookies, and clean up kitchen.

**Door Prizes** = Each scout from that den is to bring in ONE raffle prize. Only ONE prize per boy will be allowed. Suggestions: games, scout items, sport items, T-shirts, school supplies.....
