## **Catapult/Trebuchet Accuracy Scoring Guidelines**

## Material to be provided by Station Master:

- Measuring wheel
- Clipboard with pencil
- Score sheets
- Softballs

A target will be placed a set distance from the firing line. The Trebuchet/Catapult may not be moved closer, but may be moved further back or side to side if needed. The projectiles to be used will be pumpkins (or something less messy), about four inches in diameter. These "pumpkins" will be supplied by the judges. Each Trebuchet/Catapult will be allowed five shots at the target. Distances from the target will be added up from the best three shots to determine place. The shortest total distance wins.

**Scoring:** 20 points will be awarded for participation. Additional points will be awarded for a patrol's overall place in this competition.

Additional points awarded for accuracy:
