

Sled Inspection Scoring Guidelines

Material to be provided by Station Master:

Nothing

Sled Inspection

Sled is inspected for all required equipment and for proper packing; nothing should fall out when the sled is turned over. Every Scout must be wearing appropriate clothing and footwear for the conditions. This is the first event and will be conducted by the Mounties of the Wood District Territory. It will be run like a highway weigh station. Patrols will line up in two single file lines and pass through three stops. The first will check for appropriate winter clothing, the second for required equipment, and the third will determine if the gear is secured.

Appropriate Clothing:

All Scouts appropriately clothed for the weather. Appropriate clothing to be determined by Scoutmasters at Friday night meeting based on current weather conditions. It is suggested that Scouts inappropriately dressed be prohibited from competing until they change. – 8 points
Subtract 2 points for each Scout wearing inappropriate clothing.

Essential Sled Items Checklist: (2 points for each item present)

- Passport inside of a Ziploc bag
- Snow Snake
- 1 bag of mini-marshmallows
- 50 foot rope (1)
- 8-12 foot ropes (4)
- Patrol flag secured to a stick or stave
- Blindfold for each patrol member
- 1 set of snowshoes
- 1 bag of minimarshmallows
- Scout Book
- Compass for each patrol member
- 1 cement block
- Patrol first aid kit
- 1 log 4”-6” in diameter and 4’ long
- Energy snacks for morning and afternoon
- Mug or cup for each patrol member
- 5 gallon bucket with lid

Tip Test:

When the sled is tipped over, are the items still secure?

All items secure – 8 points

Subtract 1 point for each item that is not secure.

Total points possible: 50 points
